Job Title: Post-Doc in behavioral finance / experimental economics

Job Summary:

The post-doc will work on a research project on entrepreneurs' rationality, which aim is to develop an experimental protocol of validation of a survey on entrepreneurs' cognitive bias.

The post-doc is required to have a background in experimental economics and eventually to have worked on entrepreneurial related issues and to be fluent in English.

Job Description:

The post-doc will work on a research project on entrepreneurs' rationality under the supervision of Anaïs Hamelin and Marie Pfiffelmann.

The post-doc main task will consist in developing an experimental protocol of validation of a survey on entrepreneurs' cognitive bias.

More precisely this consists in:

- Reviewing the literature on cognitive bias and their measurements and the literature on entrepreneurs' cognitive bias.
- Designing the survey on entrepreneurs' cognitive bias.
- Developing the experimental protocol of validation of the survey by leading simultaneously laboratory experiments and survey administration.
- Participate to the administration of the survey to entrepreneurs.

Moreover the post-doc will be required to participate to the organization of a workshop on entrepreneurial finance and to support the research team in the setting up of research projects.

Therefore, the post-doc is required to have a background in experimental economics and eventually to have worked on entrepreneurial related issues and to be fluent in English (French is not required).
